Your child must be 5 years old by July 31, 2019 to enroll for the 2019-2020 school year.

Please call your child's school to schedule an appointment for your child's Kindergarten Readiness Screening.

&

Monday, May 13, 2019

Appointments will be scheduled between 12:00PM - 7:00PM

You do not need an appointment to register your student. However, we encourage you to make an appointment for screenings.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What to expect at the time of registration?

At the time of registration, you must present the documents listed below. School office staff will take information about your child and copy the documents presented for his/her permanent file.

Immunization Records for your child.

Children will not be accepted into kindergarten unless the following requirements are met:

- **DTaP:** (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) 4+ doses, last DTaP after the age of 4.
- **IPV:** (Polio) 3+ doses, last dose given after the age of 4.
- **MMR:** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) The child must have 2 doses, the first one given after the age of one.
- **Hep B:** (Hepatitis B) Series of 3 before entering kindergarten.
- **Varicella:** (Chicken Pox) 2 doses are a requirement for children entering school, or a written statement from a licensed doctor of medicine (MD) or doctor of osteopathy (DO), documenting the month and year that the child had chicken pox disease.
- **Eye Exam:** A comprehensive vision exam completed by an ophthalmologist or optometrist is **recommended**, but not mandatory.

The Franklin County Health Department will provide services for immunizations, by appointment only. Please call 636-583-7300 to schedule an appointment.

Official Birth Certificate

The birth certificate must be the Official State Birth Certificate with the raised seal. The hospital certificate that you received when your child was born cannot be accepted.

You will need to fill out an application and your certificate will be ready within 10-15 minutes, depending on how many requests are being processed at that time. Cost: \$15.00

Proof of Residency

Proof of residency may include a current Rental Contract signed by all parties, Real Estate Contract signed by all parties, Utility Bill, W-4 or Personal Property Tax Receipt. Please see Board Policy JEC & Policy JECA for admission and residency guidance.
